Morning:	<b>Surfing!</b> Todos Santos boasts some of the best surf breaks in Baja and our instructors guarantee that you'll ride the waves – at least for a moment! When not surfing guides will take students on an exploration of tide pools at the beach.

Morning:	<b>Nature Hike in the Sierra de la Laguna Biosphere Reserve</b> The Biosphere Reserve is one of Baja's most beautiful but least explored areas. Part of an island off the coast of Baja 10 million years ago, the Reserve is home to an incredible diversity of plant and animal life, many of them endemic species; over 23% of plants and 10% of animals found in the Reserve are endemic to the area. We'll tailor our hike and discussion to the interests and abilities of the students.
Afternoon: Evening:	Volunteer with The Palapa Society or Hogar del Niño Star Gazing and Dinner Beautiful evening of stargazing with local astronomer, followed by dinner at Santo Vino, Chef Dany Lamote's love letter to Baja. Aztec, Mayan and Greek mythologies explored while exploring the skies.

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All Day:	<b>Trip to San Vicente/Visit Mountain Potters</b> This is a fantastic opportunity to experience the traditional way of life of the mountain ranchers in Baja. We'll meet local potters in a true mountain oasis, and learn how Baja Californians have carved their homes and livings out the mountains for centuries. Doña Ramona will give us a pottery class while sharing her ranching way of life. She'll also give a cooking class, teaching students how to use the traditional metate, or grinding stone, to create beef or fish machaca. Doña Ramona and her family will share fantastic family recipes handed down through the years.
